The Village Electrification Program is Increasing Rapidly

JAKARTA - The government's program to electricity the villages are not yet electrified or who has electricity potluck is increasingly improving. If in 2015 an electrified village numbered 70,391 villages, by August 2017, electrified villages had reached 73,149 villages.

In implementing the electrified village program, PT PLN (Persero) divides it into seven regions namely Sumatra, Java-Bali, Kalimantan, Sulawesi, Nusa Tenggara, Maluku and Papua region.

Sumatra Island reaches 27,814 villages, Java - Bali as many as 27,012 villages, Kalimantan 6047 villages, Sulawesi 5,982 villages, Nusa Tenggara as many as 3,189 villages, Maluku 1,715 villages and Papua 1,390 villages.

"The electrified village program in 2017 progresses quite rapidly compared to 2015. If

look at total, 2015 is 70,391 villages and in 2017 it reaches 73,149 villages," said Director of Business of Maluku and Papua PT PLN (Persero), Ahmad Rofiq in a press conference The achievement of Electricity Subsector Quarter II 2017, Tuesday (19/9).

In carrying out the construction of an electrified village, the Government cq. PT PLN (Persero) divides into two categories, namely expansion and new. Referred to as expansion, PLN provides wider access to electricity from existing to villagers. As for the new category, PLN provides electricity access to villages that have no access to electricity at all.

Based on the data, until August 2017 recorded the construction of electrified villages in the Region of Sumatra is 232 villages (expansion), 355 villages (new). Region Java - Bali, 2,276 villages (expansion), 515 villages (new). Kalimantan, 112 villages (expansion), 87 villages (new), Sulawesi Region, 441 villages (expansion), 301 villages (new). Next to Region Nusa Tenggara, 64 villages (expansion), 528 villages (new). Maluku, 7 villages (expansion), 212 villages (new) and lastly Papua region, no expansion and 327 (new) villages.

The government is targeting in 2018 to build an electrified village across Indonesia for 1,530 villages for the expansion and 3,523 new villages. As for 2019, in all regions, an additional 1,370 villages for expansion and for new categories of 1,605 villages.

"To accelerate the improvement of the electrified villages, the government has made various efforts, among others, by more intense coordination with local governments, so there are several locations that we build together by moving the Cooperation Operation (KSO = Kerja Sama Operasi) pattern so that the acceleration program for development electric villages can be faster again," said Ahmad.
